Bringing Africa Back to the Bible



By God's grace, despite trials and tragedy, we have had a most productive year with major breakthroughs in the field. Frontline Missionaries served in 16 countries during 2018 and conducted over 1,400 meetings in 16 countries across four continents. A shaky ceasefire enabled the distribution of 32,000


Bibles and 43,000 From Creation to Christ Story of Jesus full colour booklets to the Nuba Mountains of Sudan. Our Literature4Africa

ministry distributed, completely free of charge, throughout Africa, over 2,914,000 Scriptural, Evangelistic and discipleship items. Just in time for our 7 country Africa Reformation Overland Mission, we completed the **Biblical Preaching Handbook** and received it back from the printer in time for the AROM team to deliver and distribute to pastors taking part in Back to Biblical Exposition Seminars and workshops and at Bible colleges ministered to across Zimbabwe, Zambia, Malawi, Tanzania, Botswana, Namibia and Swaziland.



Exploring the Central Messages of Every Book of the Bible As part of our Back to the Bible movement, I concluded a six-year study and preaching project going through every Book of the Bible. The Old Testament Survey was published in 2016 and the New Testament Survey is on track to be published in time for the 500th anniversary of the Swiss Reformer, Ulrich Zwingli's launch of Biblical Exposition in Grossmünster in Zürich, 1519.

Back to the Bible Mission Leader is Now Chairman of the Board



We praise God for our new Chairman of the Board of Frontline Fellowship, General Shai Mulder. Professor Shai Mulder is the Director of Back to the Bible Mission, where for the last 18 years, he and his team, have trained thousands of pastors, evangelists, missionaries and college lecturers from over 30 countries in Africa, ensuring that they are thoroughly grounded in every Book of the Bible. Dr. Mulder has made Back to the Bible Mission the most effective, Bible-based, Christ-centered, missionary-minded, prayerful and evangelistic training institution of ministry of the Gospel in Africa since 2007. It has

been a joy and a privilege to be part of his faculty as a regular guest lecturer dealing with Missions, Church History and Biblical Worldview.

Mission Growth and Baby Boom

This year it was also a joy to add my son-in-law, Hunter, as a new full time missionary. He completed his Masters in Divinity at Phoenix Theological Seminary last year and moved his small, but growing, family to Cape Town. 7th November ushered in the arrival of our second grandchild, Joshua Ellis, born to Andrea in the same hospital where I was born, in 1960.



Our missionary John, was glad to receive reinforcements from his friend Hunter and his family is also growing with his and Rachel's second child, Rose, born 23 September. We also had the joy of commissioning our Missionary, Abraham, before he led a five-person mission team on the 7-country Africa Reformation Overland Mission (117 meetings over 15,000 km). Abraham first joined our Mission in January 2015 and has been an energetic and capable missionary initiating many evangelistic outreaches, repairing many vehicles, demonstrating carpentry and electrician skills, fixing whatever needed fixing and repairing whatever needed repairing, painting, or building as needed. His and Taryn's family grew with the birth of their first daughter, Emma, born 7 January

(during our Biblical Worldview Summit 2018!) Along with other Fellowship mothers, there is now a regular Mother's Meeting held at the Mission.

Bibles to the Nuba Mountains of Sudan Mission

In May, when Ben (whose wife is pregnant), John, Hunter and Abraham, all headed off to the Bibles for the Nuba Mountains Mission, all four team members were married, three with young children at home and three with their wives expecting, including our own daughter, Andrea. Although I took similar risks when our children were just as young, it is obviously much harder to trust God for other people's safety and I have seldom felt more burdened in prayer for one of our teams in the field. By God's grace, Ben, John, Hunter and Abraham succeed in distributing over 32,000 Bibles and 43,000 *Story of Jesus* books to 130 schools in the remote Nuba Mountains of Sudan. To my knowledge, this is the largest shipment of Bibles ever delivered into an officially Islamic country.

Missionary Interns

In January, Francis completed her two-year-In service Missionary Apprenticeship Training through our Livingstone Missionary School. Francis was awarded her certificate and prayed for by Frontline Board Member (now Chairman), Dr. Shai Mulder at our Sunday service at the **Biblical Worldview Summit**. Last year, Joseph also completed our Missionary Apprenticeship Training programme and since proposed to Francis. They were engaged in June when they accompanied me during our South Africa Mission around the country, conducting the **Biblical Worldview Seminar** in Pretoria, ministering at the Bible College Consultation at Adullum Mission and at the KwaSizabantu Mission outreach in

Tugela Valley, at the Youth Conference at KwaSizabantu Mission and numerous other outreaches. In December, Joseph and Francis were married in Pretoria and we enjoyed a reception for them back near Cape Town shortly afterwards. Four new missionary interns joined our mission after the Great Commission Course 2018: Emma, Alieske, Alpha and Ray.


From the Frontline



In February, 2018, we launched a new radio podcast <u>From the Frontline</u>. Every Tuesday night at 9pm, I, along with other missionaries of Frontline Fellowship, present a fresh, uncensored perspective on the real news behind the news headlines, focusing especially on the persecuted church and what God is doing in these difficult and challenging times in Restricted Access Areas, tackling some of the most contentious concerns, threats and challenges facing the church today. You can listen to any of these audio interviews/programmes (48 so far) on our <u>Audio Galley</u>.

Threats to Faith and Freedom in South Africa

In February, the national assembly of the South African parliament sent shockwaves around the country and the world, by setting in motion a process to change the constitution to allow expropriation of property without compensation. This threat to private ownership of property and the clearly stated intention to remove constitutional safeguards and protections of private ownership has staggered observers. This has come along with an ominous increase in farm invasions, arson attacks, violent riots in the streets, increasing terrorism and tortures of farmers on remote homesteads and incredibly incendiary statements from communist leaders, including members of Parliament, in South Africa calling for the genocide of all whites in South Africa.



Resisting the Second Phase of the Revolution

Yet, bad times are good for spiritual work. Apathy can be our greatest enemy and even the apathetic are concerned now. Several other writing projects were placed on hold, as I needed to respond to this drastic deterioration in the security situation in South Africa. Providentially, my new book. Security and Survival Handbook had just come back from the printer and has been much in demand since. I received many invitations to speak at Farming communities, including Kragdag, a major farming event, on Security and Survival and Home Education. I was also asked to present a seminar dealing with understanding The Crisis in South Africa. Also, providentially, our newly launched Henry Morton Stanley School

of Christian Journalism website and Facebook page was able to direct much focus on the Farms and Freedom Under Fire in South Africa; Is South Africa Entering the Second Phase of the Revolution?;

Fraud, Failure and Farce – Land Expropriation Hearings; The Nine Stages of Genocide in South Africa; Fearless Farmers that Fight Back; How Marxists Subvert Churches and Society and much more. Many concerned Christian radio and TV programmers worldwide requested interviews to provide clarity and insight as to what is going on in South Africa and what can practically be done to assist those being targeted and to bring pressure to bear against the communist dominated ANC government in South Africa and their insanely suicidal policy of following Zimbabwe's disastrous land reform programme.




Serving Remote Communities Targeted by Revolutionaries

With such blatant attempts to subvert private ownership of property and the rule of law and to tear up constitutional guarantees and safeguards, there has been an escalating lawlessness spreading throughout the country. As a result, I had to give much more attention to missions to remote farming areas around South Africa, dealing with practical strategies for protecting homes, churches, farms, mission stations, Bible colleges and communities from the rising tide of communist inspired violence and terrorism. These precious people need much prayer, encouragement, counsel and ministry from the Word of God.



Writing and Printing Projects

Major writing and printing projects completed this year included: The revised <u>Ten Commandments</u> <u>– God's Perfect Law of Liberty</u>, the <u>Security and Survival Handbook</u>; the <u>Biblical Preaching Handbook</u>; we updated and revised the <u>Church History Manual</u>; published <u>The Wonders of Water</u>; <u>Prison Break</u>; <u>The Rise of the GayGB and The Pink Inquisition</u>; and completed the translations of <u>Sketches from South African History</u> into <u>Sketse Uit Die Suid Afrikaanse Geskiedenis</u> (which also includes additional chapters from Stephen Mitford Goodson and an Introduction from Cuan Elgin (Author of <u>Bulala</u>) and <u>Praktiese Dissipelskap</u>, a translation of our <u>Practical Discipleship</u> book.



Another Stolen Election Crushes Hope in Zimbabwe

Across the border, our near neighbour, Zimbabwe, suffered another rigged and stolen election under the Marxist ZANU-PF government. Desperate for hope, the longsuffering people of Zimbabwe had dared to hope for a new dawn of freedom after 38 years of Marxist misrule under Robert Mugabe who was ousted by the military, 21 November 2017 (see: Zimbabwe Celebrates as Mugabe Falls and What is Happening in Zimbabwe?).

These have been just some of the daily realities which our Mission has sought to confront and deal with in a bold, balanced and Biblical way. Boxes with Love for Destitute Pensioners

As part of our ministry to body, mind and spirit, our Love in Action ministry seeks to prepare and deliver *Boxes with Love* to pensioners, prisoners and pastors in Marxist Zimbabwe who have lost their life savings due to the collapse of the economy. Each donated package is filled with tins and packets of food, medicines, literature and other desperately needed and hard to obtain treats.

Home Education Open Days

We have also regularly hosted open days for home educators and their children. One South African History Open Day included 85 participants, straining our crowded Mission house. Our next Church History day focussed on The Middle Ages. There were parallel programmes for parents and older children, which I dealt with and a children's programme which Emma, John, Alieske, Marina and Alpha focussed on. We updated and expanded our <u>Church History Manual</u> in time for this. New Audio Visual Boxsets

New Audio Visual Boxsets produced this year, include: The Great Commission Course 2018 (3 MP3 audio discs containing 54 lectures and a data DVD containing 29 PDF books and manuals, 88 lecture notes and 54 PowerPoint presentations); USA and Europe Reformation 500 Mission (4 disc boxset, including 19 audio messages on 2 MP3 and 23 video presentations/ screen captures, 19 lecture notes, 16 PDF books and a Eurochor in Wittenberg Concert video on 2 data DVDs); Mission to Australia (3 disc boxset including 15 audio messages on an MP3 and 14 video presentations/ screen captures, 14 lecture notes and 17 PDF books on 2 data DVDs); Biblical Preaching and Discernment Workshop (4 disc boxset including one MP3 audio disc



containing 14 lectures and 2 video DVDs with 4 lectures and a data DVD containing 4 screen captures, 88 Puritan sermons, 5 PDF books, 14 lecture notes, 8 PowerPoint presentations and 12 short films); and Spiritual Warfare Workshop (2 disc audio and data boxset including an MP3 audio disc with 5 audio lectures and one data DVD containing 4 screen capture video presentations, 9 PDF lectures notes, 7 printable tracts, a PDF book and 5 Power Point presentations).

Literature4Africa



Literature4Africa received, offloaded and sorted through six container shipments (each 20 foot/18 tonnes) including 125 pallets, 3,634 boxes and 3,588 study packs, in the last year. Our ministry has distributed 68,000 LITERATURE Bibles; 58,620 Theological and library books; 390,000 children's Sunday school booklets and manuals; 144,000 Gospel of John and



Epistle of Romans booklets; 50,000 full colour Gospel booklets; 74,500 World Missionary Press Gospel booklets in almost 100

languages; 189,000 devotional booklets and magazines; 168,000 tracts; 10,500 Chapel Library booklets, 71,640 group and personal devotional study books and 1,650,000 audio visual materials, including CDs and DVDs. That is 2,914,160 Scriptural evangelistic and discipleship materials, freely distributed throughout Africa this last year.






Translation Projects




We praise God that two of our most popular and in demand books have been translated into Afrikaans, including: Sketches from South African History into Sketse Uit Die Suid Afrikaanse Geskiedenis and Practical Discipleship into Praktiese Dissipelskap. These books arrived back from the printer in time for me to launch them at the Day of the Covenant Geloftefees on 16 December, the 180th anniversary of the Battle of Blood River. This was a most historic time to launch our new books amongst an Afrikaans community in Clanwilliam, nearly 3 hours North of Cape Town.



New Writing and Printing Projects

Along with completing the <u>New Testament Survey</u>, Colin and I have been helping Schalk Visagie bring out his **Under Fire in South Africa** book. These should both be ready for the printer and available

before the end of January 2019. There are numerous other writing projects, which were delayed because of all the revolutionary activity in South Africa, which needed to be responded to, both in writing and at public meetings, on the radio and TV. However, God willing, this coming year, I will continue to work on completing The Greatest Century of Persecution; Exposing the Lies We Have Believed; War Against God; A Christian History of Africa; Dedicated Discipleship; Frontline - Behind Enemy Lines for Christ; Bible Character Studies; The Life and Legacy of Dr. David Livingstone;



Reformation and Revival in Romania (a book by Bill Bathman which has not yet been brought to print) and Angola's Agony. Other Frontline books, which will soon be out of print and need to be revised, updated and reprinted, include: In the Killing Fields of Mozambique; Answering Skeptics and Power of Prayer Handbook. Other translations into Afrikaans, which are also awaiting funds to be printed, are: Antwoorde Vir Skeptici and Ou-Testamentiese Opname. We are also wanting to produce a Biblical Worldview Handbook and a Great Commission Handbook.



Christian Liberty Books

CLB set up book tables at numerous home schooling events. CLB also organised gift packs of free books and audio visuals for graduating students of Bible Institute. Best sellers in 2018 were: <u>Die Tien Gebooie, Sketches from South African History, Security and Survival Handbook</u> and Stephen Mitford Goodson's books on <u>Hendrik Frensch Verwoerd, Genocide of the Boers</u> and <u>A History of Central Banking and Enslavement of Man</u>. Cuan Elgin's book, <u>Bulala</u> was also in our top ten. By far, the most popular audiovisual materials were the <u>South African History</u> audio and data MP3 boxset, the <u>Biblical Preaching and Discernment Workshop</u> and <u>Reformation 500</u> audio and data boxsets. The bestselling DVDs were <u>Andrew Murray – Africa for Christ</u> and <u>Agenda 2 - Masters of Deceit</u>.

From Australia to America

In 2018, I completed 9 Missions, including 25 flights, drove long distances, ministered throughout South Africa, Australia and America, giving over 450 presentations, lectures or sermons, including 220 radio and 25 TV interviews. This does not include leading over 200 prayer meetings and 20 outreaches.









Frontline Fellowship actively manages over 20 Facebook pages with a combined 168,359,428 total impressions/hits/visits over the last year. Videos Online

Frontline is using YouTube and <u>Vimeo</u> as online distribution channels. We uploaded 169 new videos onto YouTube this year and have a total of 340 video with the most popular on YouTube being: Communism in Africa (9,186 views). The Frontline channel on **Vimeo** had 25,604 total plays last year with the most popular being Life Chain 2018 (3,704 views); *Armistice 100; Remembrance Day in Rhodesia* and *A Biblical Response to Halloween*. The top countries viewing our videos include United States, South Africa, United Kingdom and Australia. During 2018, we added 174 new videos onto our **Vimeo** channel, which now has 371 videos available.

Podbean

This year we initiated a new podcast series <u>From the Frontline</u>, which is uploaded every Tuesday evening. We have uploaded 48 podcasts so far.

Soundcloud

In the last year we uploaded 332 new audio tracts, making a total of 491 radio programmes and audio presentations uploaded and available online through <u>Soundcloud</u>. Our most popular programmes were *The Victorious Gospel in Zimbabwe, Zambia, Botswana and Uganda; Under Fire for the Faith – International Day of Prayer* and *The Power of Gospel Literature*. Top countries for audio downloads from Soundcloud are United States, South Africa and Sweden.

Sermon Audio

This year we uploaded 193 new sermons and lectures on <u>Sermon Audio</u>, making a total of 642 sermons available online through Sermon Audio. Total downloads are 128,285. Of these 60,698 were mobile downloads. Most popular were *A Modern Idol – The Truth About Martin Luther King Jnr; The Five Points of Calvinism in the Teachings of Christ; Animals in Heaven; Dealing with Deception in the Media and The Failure of Atheism* and *The Triumph of Faith in Russia*.


Slideshare

In 2018, we uploaded 19 new PowerPoints onto <u>Slideshare</u>, making a total of 236 of our presentations available online. Total views and downloads in 2018 were 67,044, with the most popular being *Mandela Day and the Making of a New Religion; The Ten Commandments* and *The Assassination of General George S. Patton*. Top countries downloading our Slideshare are United States, South Africa, Philippines and Germany.

Audio Visual Ministry

In 2018, our Audio Visual department processed 43 new Livingstone Fellowship sermons, 48 Reformation Society lectures, 143 video screen captures, 109 radio interviews, 44 podcasts and 5 MP3 audio, visual and data boxsets.

Field Worker Reports



John spoke at 129 meetings, conducted 49 outreaches and led 200 prayer meetings during this year. This included speaking to 33 schools in the Nuba Mountains, reaching over 9,400 students, openair preaching, radio and TV ministry and overseeing the distribution of 6,660 Bibles and 11,755 Story of Jesus booklets to 51 schools in the Nuba Mountains. Aside from our Biblical Worldview Summit and Great Commission Course, John also led the Biblical Worldview Seminar at Atlantis, the Biblical Preaching Workshop and a Vacation Bible School. He helped grade course work for correspondence students of William Carey Bible Institute, helped

organise our Africa Reformation Overland Mission and graduated with Honours from South African Theological Seminary. John and Rachel were blessed with a healthy birth of their second child, Rose.

Abraham completed missions to Sudan, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Malawi, Tanzania, Botswana, Namibia and Swaziland. He conducted over 100 meetings and 34 outreaches. Abrie and Taryn were blessed with the birth of their first child, Emma, 7 January. Having completed over 3 years Missionary in-service

training before leading the 7 Country Reformation Overland Mission, Abraham was commissioned as a Missionary of Frontline Fellowship.

Hunter completed a mission to the Nuba Mountains of Sudan and a South African Overland Mission, which included lecturing on Biblical Ethics at Back to the Bible Mission. Since moving to Cape Town in February, Hunter spoke at 77 meetings, including open-air preaching and ministering at school assemblies in the Nuba Mountains, leading Discovery Bible Studies at University of Cape Town and ministry on radio. She has completed over 60 outreaches to malls, universities and Muslim communities and led 21 Bible studies up at University of Cape Town. Emma also helps marks assignments for William Carey Bible Institute.

Our missionary interns, Alieske, Alpha and Ray participated in hundreds of prayer meetings, outreaches and practicals. Alieske helped re-organise our Libraries, completed the Africa Reformation Overland Mission across 7 countries, spoke at many schools, teaching 7 C's of History, the Ten Commandments and Evangelism Explosion Gospel presentations to school children. Alpha and Ray have helped Jonathan with the <u>Literature4Africa</u> ministry and taken part in many of the outreaches to Muslims in Cape Town and to students at the local university.

Ben is co-ordinating another ambitious series of container shipments for Sudan and Uganda including: 40,000 Bibles, 20,000 note pads for school children, 35,000 Story of Jesus - Creation to Christ picture books in English and another 15,000 in Arabic, 2,000 copies of Faith Under Fire in Sudan, 2,000 copies of the Chaplain's Handbook, 2,000 copies of The Greatest Century of Missions, 2,000 Biblical Principles for Africa, 7,000 Catechism Courses in English and 1,500 in Arabic. We praise God for the generous designated giving that has made these Bibles and books to the Nuba Mountains projects possible. Of course there are still additional costs involved, including transportation, clearing of customs and all the travel expenses of our mission team. As a Faith mission, we do not take up offerings, nor engage in fund raising. We do everything we can with what is entrusted to us by prayer supporters who believe in this work.

Urgent Needs

Our ageing fleet of field vehicles desperately needs replacing. The last new vehicles (not that they were new, but purchased second-hand) were obtained in 2011 because of the dedicated vision of Frontline Chairman of the Board, Rev. Bill Bathman. All these vehicles have since driven hundreds-of-thousands of kilometres and are becoming dangerously unreliable and needing constant mechanical attention. We are earnestly praying for designated support to replace these vital Mission vehicles essential for the Africa Reformation Overland Missions throughout Africa. With the high cost of postage and unreliability of most postal services throughout Africa, most of our literature distribution is done through these vehicles alongside the Leadership Training Programmes in the field.

With all the steady growth at our headquarters, Livingstone House is bursting at the seams and building expansion is desperately needed. We already have architect plans approved for converting our attic into a multi-purpose hall with extra rooms for missionaries and guests. This project needs designated funds to go ahead, as does the Livingstone Farm and Missionary Training School.
