

BWS & GCC Guidelines for Men's Dress Code

“For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.” 1 John 2:16

“For I am the Lord that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.” Leviticus 11:45

- Please dress smartly and modestly at all times. Wear gender-appropriate clothing.
- Ensure that your hair is kept neat, and that you shave regularly – no stubble.
- For the Sunday services and outreaches, men must dress neatly. Tie and button up shirt should be worn throughout the service.
- Shirts are to be worn at all times. Please do not appear outside of your room or tent without a shirt.
- Shorts and vests may be worn during PT or outdoor events, but a golf shirt or T-shirt covering your shoulders should be worn during lecture times.
- Pyjamas are for sleeping in only.
- Overly tight body-hugging shirts are inappropriate.
- Hairstyle and fashions should avoid extremes. Slogans on clothing should not promote anything against Biblical values including unbiblical books, movies, bands, etc.
- Remove hats/caps and hoods indoors, especially during prayer and Hymn singing.
- If you are unsure whether or not something is appropriate, ask!

“I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.” Romans 12:1-2

As you pack, keep in mind that this is a Christian course. Neat and modest clothing is to be worn *at all times*.

- No strapless tops on blouses or dresses
- No spaghetti strap tops on dresses or tank tops
- No bared backs below the normal bra line
- No tight shirts, shirts should always cover your stomach and back
- No visible cleavage, wear a higher cut shirt underneath V-necklines
- No dresses, skirts or shorts cut above the bottom of the knee, even while sitting
- No slits that bare the thighs; slits must not come above the bottom of the knee
- No “mermaid” outfits that snugly follow all the contours of the body
- Wear a slip underneath a sheer skirt or dress
- Any tattoos should be covered, as far as realistically possible

Your clothes worn during sports time should also be modest.

- Clothing for PT and physical activities and adventure activities: Shorts or skirts cut below the knee and a modest t-shirt
- Swim wear: No bikinis or excessively short shorts; stomachs should be covered; wear swim shorts and a dark T-shirt over your swimsuit.

Clothing worn to all lectures should be neater than clothing for activities. Modest dresses and skirts for the Sunday worship service and outreaches.

This is a Christian camp; please conduct yourselves in a respectable, honourable and pure manner – no flirty or suggestive attitudes.

Those ladies coming on the full GCC need to bring at least 3 skirts as they need to wear skirts for outreaches (everyday) and church services each Sunday.
