“Know God’s Word, disciple those in your immediate influence, pray with family, vote Biblically, use social media wisely”; “Diligent and disciplined Bible study – when you know God’s will you will know what to do”; “Evangelising. Do God’s Will. Give your life over to Him”; “Preach the Gospel without compromise to everyone in their sphere of influence. Mobilise more Biblical evangelist/training in local churches. The Gospel changes everything”; “Stand together and evangelise”; “Help educate the uneducated, pray and evangelise”; “Obey God’s command for us and to be firm in His Word and maintain daily devotions to Him”; “Speak out”; “Being a living example of fellowship”; “Get informed, intercede and get involved”; “Obey Matthew 9:35-38, Look, Pray, Send, Go and be informed, interceding and involved”; “Start a Bible Study group and work through the whole Bible”; “Let the Bible influence every area of our lives. Study the Bible Biblically. That will lead to different dress, action and speak to others about the Gospel”; “Saturate yourself in Scripture”.
